FALL 2012 TRANSFER (TR)

- California Community College (CCC) transfer is a UC priority
 - 80% of CCC applicants qualified & admitted
- UC Davis TR Apps - 13,126 **3% Decrease**
 - 11,740 CCC apps **89% of Pool**
- UC TR Apps – 36,640 **4% Decrease**
 - 26,265 UC CCC apps **71% of Pool**
- UC Davis fall 2011
 - Admit = 7,233
 - Enroll = 2,770



TRANSFER ADMISSION PROGRAMS

- Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)
 - 112 CCC's
- Transfer Opportunity Program (TOP)
 - 16 participating CCC's
 - UC Davis Adviser on CCC site

TRANSFER ADMISSIONS GUARANTEE (TAG)

- UC Davis TAG – The First!
 - The Los Rios CCC District – TAA - 1985
 - First guarantee program in the state
 - Ensures students receive advising
 - Facilitates ease of transfer to UC Davis



- UC TAG
 - Seven(7) UC campuses participate
 - Various types and processes

UC DAVIS TAG

- CCC Counselor & UC Davis Adviser
- Full evaluation and advising services
- Ensure transferability of courses, units, UC admission, and UC major selection
- TAG contract a year in advance
- Online TAG, student & counselor views



UC DAVIS TAG FALL 2012

- Submitted: 3,246
 - 569 Not Authorized by CCC
- Reviewed: 2,677
- Approved: 2,307
- Applied: 2,128*
- Guaranteed Admission – Meet Contract

UC DAVIS TAG PLAN WITH ASSIST.ORG

- Essential online tool
- Statewide database serving CCC students
- Details courses at CCC
 - Transferability
 - Comparability – Articulation
 - IGETC / General Education (GE)
 - Exploring majors



UC DAVIS TAG-CRITERIA

- To submit TAG, have already completed:
 - 30 semester/45 quarter units with an overall GPA of 3.2 (3.3 ENGR)
- To qualify, submit a plan to complete by the end of the next spring term:
 - 60 semester/90 quarter units
 - UC transfer admission requirements in English, math, and a 4-course pattern
 - Required major courses with a specified course group GPA



UC DAVIS TAG-TIMELINE

- **Once enrolled at a CCC:** Begin the UC TAG Application online
- **May,** one year prior to planned enrollment: View updated UC Davis TAG criteria
- **September,** one year prior to planned enrollment: Submit the UC TAG Application
- **Mid-November:** Receive the UC Davis TAG decision and contract
- **November 1-30:** File the UC application for undergraduate admission & scholarships
- **January:** Complete the UC Transfer Academic Update
- **April-Mid:** Receive admission notification

UC DAVIS TAG A GUARANTEE PLAN

- A beneficial program that provides a plan to guarantee transfer admission.
- An opportunity, not a requirement.
- Many students are competitive for UC Davis admission without TAG.



TRANSFER ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS




TRANSFER ADMISSION UC REQUIREMENTS

- 2.40 GPA – UC Minimum
 - 2.80 GPA or higher UC Davis
- 60 semester/90 quarter units
- Two courses of English composition
- One course of college-level math
- Four courses among three subject areas



SELECTIVE MAJORS

- College of Biological Sciences
College of Engineering
 - All majors
- College of Ag. & Env. Sciences
 - Biotechnology and Viticulture & Enology
- College of Letters & Science
 - Communication, Psychology and International Relations
- Must earn a “C” grade or better
- Core courses or series with required GPA



HOW TO INCREASE TRANSFER CHANCES

- Highest priority given to junior-level CCC transfers
- Meet UC transfer admission requirements
- Competitive UC Davis GPA 2.80 or higher
- Prepare for the major
- Apply broadly
- List an alternate major, alternate area




UC DAVIS FALL 2011 PROFILE
