The Band Play-a-Thon is just a few weeks away, on **January 22 through 23**, Saturday night through Sunday morning. Parents, don't worry! The event will be held in the Emerson Junior High MPR this year, not in the DHS MPR as it normally is, due to repairs.

Band Booster Minutes ~ December 1, 2010 □

The meeting was called to order at 7:32 p.m.

<u>Approval of Minutes</u> - The minutes from our November meeting as printed in the newsletter were unanimously approved.



<u>Music Director's Report</u> - There were two wonderful concerts last month. Kudos were given to our guest performers, Julie Hochman and Eric Berger. Mr. Lange was impressed with both bands. This Saturday the Jazz Band is participating in the Delta Jazz Festival in Stockton. The Winter Rhapsody concert on 12/16 with Concert Band and Symphonic Band features student Christine Chu on flute.

<u>Student Report</u> - Band sweatshirts were ordered and should be arriving this week. Band Boosters are fronting the money for them but will be paid back as students purchase them. Mr. Lange will remind Duncan to provide a list of which basketball games he would like the band to perform. The first game may be 12/14.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> - Joyce has nothing prepared for this evening. We are in very good shape to pay for the first trip deposits.

Committee Reports -

- A. <u>Direct Donations</u> We have collected \$12,771 to date. Mr. Lange has purchased a new alto clarinet for \$1,660.
- B. <u>Rent-a-Band</u> Several people have hired groups this year. There are three great student leaders, yet not many students have signed up to participate. We will revisit this new format of 12 in a group to see how successful it is. The week of rehearsals was quite busy, which may have deterred students from participating. Maki proposed a change in how much students will earn per gig, which we agreed to. Maki will provide each leader with a roster of all the students participating with their phone numbers.
- C. Pizza and Yogurt Yogurt Shack closed.
- D. <u>Play-a-Thon</u> This year's event will probably be held at Emerson MPR. We may consider selling sweats, or scarves. The pledge sheets will be distributed soon. It will be posted on the website.
- E. <u>Coconut Grove</u> 3/11/2011 We need to confirm a space for this event. Emerson and Harper are both reserved. John will contact Kate Bowen on how the Jazz Choir Cabaret is set up at Emerson. A planning meeting will be held in the next couple weeks. Three people have offered to assist in the coordination of this event. Our decorations are still in the MPR. We are working on finding a new space to store them. John will follow up with the school to discuss inventory cleaning and moving.
- F. <u>Concerts, CD/DVD/Snack Sales</u> Joyce needs checks for CD and DVD orders. Michael George is coordinating sales. Tom Estes is creating the CDs and DVDs. At the Winter Rhapsody concert on 12/16, Davis Media Access will do the video recording and Tom Estes will do the audio recording. Julie Hochman and Cliva Mee have been coordinating the snack sales.
- G. <u>Jazz Band Update</u> The Jazz Band will be participating in the Delta Jazz Festival on Saturday 12/4/10. The field trip forms have been sent out and carpools are being organized. We have a district employee who is certified in CPR going along with the band.
- H. <u>Victoria Spring Trip</u> Airline and hotel reservations have been made. The district contracts have been signed. We are confirming activities including a swimming night and a pizza party night. All forms are available on the website and John is sending out emails to all with account information. First installments are due by 12/10/10. We have plenty of chaperones. If you haven't let Katie know that you want to be a chaperone or a roadie on the trip, please contact her ASAP.
- I. <u>Scrip</u> The new Nugget cards have arrived. You need to register them online to activate the cards. They will be much easier to use at the cash register. We encourage everyone to get a card from Lynne if you did not already receive a new card in the mail. John received information on a new Scrip program for Costco, Target and Whole Foods.
- J. <u>Program Inserts</u> Anyone wanting an insert in the concert programs (e.g. Coconut Grove, Play-A-Thon, Scrip) should have it to Mr. Lange by Monday 12/13/10.

Old Business -

- A. <u>BB positions That Need Filling ASAP</u> Coconut Grove Co-Coordinator John will be talking to the three people who offered to assist with the coordination and see if they will co-chair the event.
- B. Clothing Swap Plans John will find out from Cliva Mee if anything needs to be done now.
- C. Repetitive Stress Injury Clinic This is being planned for a date in January.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:42 p.m.
