♪ Band Director's Message ♪

February was a stellar month for our bands at DHS!

First, our Jazz Band received some great news – we were invited to compete in the **Monterey Next Generation Jazz Festival** to be held the first weekend in April! In order to receive this invitation, we had to submit an audition recording. Bands from across the country, and even some from foreign lands, vied for a spot... and our group was selected – one of only twelve from the vast pool of high school bands!

Second, our Symphonic Band took part in the annual **Festivity of Bands** in our own IPAB, along with the bands from UCD and CSUS. For those of you who were there, I think you can see the high caliber of musicianship we have at DHS – we held our own with these high-powered groups!

Now, what about March???

All the bands will be in high gear with the top down this month, so hold on to your hats!

The first event is the annual **Coconut Grove** to be held **March 12th** at Emerson Junior High Commons. For those of you who don't know about this event, it is a Jazz Concert/Dance, featuring young jazz performers from all over the city. The jazz bands from Emerson and Harper, Celia Cottle's 3 groups, and our own DHS Jazz Band will perform. But that's not all – this is a fundraiser for ALL THE BAND STUDENTS – those who aren't performing will be working the evening, serving the delightful appetizers and desserts. More detailed information is found elsewhere in this newsletter, but I suggest you get your tickets early!

A very important event for the Concert and Symphonic Bands takes place on Thursday, **March 17th** in our own IPAB Theater. I'm talking about the annual **Adjudication Concert**. This is the opportunity for someone outside our

circle of friends to come to DHS, listen to the work being done by our students, and evaluate the performances.

The inspiration for this concert came a few years ago when I realized that in order to take our two bands to a festival, it would cost us almost \$1,000 for fees and buses. I decided that for a portion of that amount, I could instead hire a noted band authority from this area to come to DHS and work with our students. That way, instead of getting only written comments and some garbled tape recordings, I would be able to have the adjudicator work personally with the students – showing them how to improve.

The format of the day is as follows... during 7th period (Concert Band), we will play for the adjudicator and then he will have almost an hour to present to the students. At the concert that evening, the Concert Band will again repeat their performance from the afternoon. Brief comments will be given, and then there will be an intermission. The Symphonic Band will then perform and the adjudicator will spend awhile presenting to them.

The adjudicator I've invited this year is **Mr. Eric Hammer**, Director of Bands from the University of the Pacific in Stockton. Mr. Hammer has worked with our students at previous Play-a-Thons and always brings new insights to our students.

And the music? Well, the Concert Band will be performing "Dances Americanesque", "Polly Oliver", and "Kachina Dance" (an musical excursion into the world of American Indian). The Symphonic Band will be presenting "Blue Shades" (best described as Igor Stravinsky meets Benny Goodman!), "Resting In The Peace of His Hands," and "Early Light." Donations will gladly be accepted at the door, although no formal admission will be charged. This concert will begin at 7:30 p.m. and will end at about 9:00 p.m.

But the month doesn't end there! On Sunday, **March 20th** the Jazz Band will again take the IPAB stage for a "**Battle of the Bands**" with the Jazz Band from CSU Sacramento. This is a warm-up for our performance at the Monterey Next Generation Jazz Festival the following weekend. Again, starts at 7:30 p.m., and again, donations accepted at the door.

♪ Band Booster Minutes ~ February 2, 2011 ♪

I. Approval of Minutes -

The minutes from the January meeting as published in the February newsletter were unanimously approved.



II. Music Director's Report -

Mr. Lange says many students are participating in the NorCal Honor Band, and a few more students are participating in the All-State Honor Band. Spencer Park is playing with the All-State Orchestra. The Symphonic Band will be performing with CSUS and UCD bands at DHS in the Festivity of Bands; Jeanette Vance is working on advertising for this performance. Coconut Grove and the Adjudication Concert occur in March. Les Lehr will be the adjudicator.

III. Student Report -

Pep Band—The pep band is playing as a basketball game tonight and Friday night.

IV. Treasurer's Report -

Joyce has a recap for the year. For details contact the Treasurer. Very good cash position. Paid \$33,000 in airfare and we still have \$67K to cover upcoming expenses.

V. Committee Reports -

A. Direct Donations - Another \$25 trickled in. My records show \$17,576 collected.

B. Rent-a-Band Close Out - Maki said the actual events ran much better this year with larger ensembles of 6-8 students. Events were better quality and better organized. The television publicity was fun but not accurate. The student leaders did a good job. The rehearsals were not at a very convenient time for many students.

C. Pizza and Yogurt - We have a pizza fundraiser at Lamppost on 2/15. Mr. Lange encouraged Katie to pass out flyers at the elementary concert next Wednesday.

D. Play-a-Thon Feedback - The event went well. The venue seemed to work better at Emerson with an enclosed patio, inside bathrooms, and break room. However, the stage was dark. Sandra will send Mr. Dupertis something to thank him for using his space. We had four directors, two who did a huge amount of work and two who did a lot of work. Mr. Lange will send them thank you gifts. Sandra will provide Mr. Lange with ideas for the two female conductors.

E. Coconut Grove 3/12/11 - The students have signed up for nearly all the jobs. Karen has been doing a really good job getting all the pieces pulled together. Decorations are being collected. New decorations are being purchased to replace the tired and mold-exposed decorations.

F. Concerts, CD/DVD Sales - Nothing to report.

G. Jazz Band Update - Capital Jazz Project is only available one date, but the IPAB is not available, so David will need to contact them and cancel the concert with them this year. David will contact them earlier in our school year to put a date on the calendar for 2012. If we get into Monterey, David will need to contact Portola Hotel for reservations and submit all the DJUSD forms. Mr. Lange will think of other groups to contact that may be able to play with the Jazz Band instead of CJP. 4/17 Jazz Band and Jazz Combo concert for sure.

H. Victoria Spring Trip - The airline tickets have been purchased. Interested students need to submit t-shirt designs for contest by Friday 2/4/11. Third installments are due beginning of March. Balance will be collected beginning of April. Katie will not be able to finalize the itinerary until a few weeks just before the trip.

I. Scrip - Lynne can email friends and alumni if they are interested in participating in the Scrip program. The Target credit program supports schools generally. Individual groups may be able to receive a portion of this. Lynne will investigate.

J. Others - Mark Stephens will be building a shelf for a cost of about \$200.

K. Snacks - John Horn will contact Peggy about serving bottled water and refreshments at the Festivity of Bands concert.

VI. Old/New Business -

A. An old concert of the Davis High School Jazz Band was broadcasted on the local television.

B. A group of DaVinci students has devised a solar powered blender for a "green" restaurant in Nicaragua. They are having a pasta feed on Sat 2/5 as a fundraiser for the trip to deliver the blender. An announcement will be sent to band families announcing the pasta feed.

C. Mr. Lange requests any input on calendar dates for next school year. Event requests should be sent to John Horn who will submit them to Mr. Lange by March 17th. We may want to consider a change in dates for the Play-A-Thon. John Horn will coordinate with Sandra Weisker and Jeanette Vance for ideas with the Play-a-thon for next year, including a student survey.

D. Coconut Grove used to include dancing and was just the DHS Jazz Band. Now with more bands performing there is not the opportunity for dancing.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:19 p.m.
