

November marks the beginning of our concert season with the DHS bands, and we have a pair of them for you this month.

On Monday, **November 15**, the DHS **Symphonic Band** will present "**Legends and Scoundrels**," a themed-concert dealing with music about the famous and infamous throughout history. The program includes a monumental work for band with solo 'cello entitled "Casanova." You will need to be the judge about whether he is a legend or scoundrel. Out guest artist on 'cello is Ms. Julie Hochman (you might remember she played with the Symphonic Band last year in the Symphonic Dances from West Side Story). But I'm not going to tell you everything. Just remember I told you that you won't believe your ears or eyes in this exciting presentation.

Five days later, on **November 19**, our DHS **Jazz Band** will present their annual "**Jazz Extravaganza.**" This concert has been an annual pre-Thanksgiving treat for 24 years. The group has been working hard this year and is now ready for their first major performance. As an added attraction, we will have a special guest artist join our band for this performance. Trombonist, Eric Burger, is one of DHS' own! He graduated in the 1970's and went to a number of colleges before playing his trombone for Uncle Sam in Iraq, Afghanistan, and in the most

GREAT NEWS... Our Spring Trip to Victoria, Canada has been approved by the District! 120 students have confirmed that they are going on the trip, and a few are still deciding. We will be making nonrefundable airline payments in early January, so we need to have our list of trip participants finalized soon. Official dates for the trip are Thursday, May 19th (after school) to Tuesday, May 24th (in the evening). If you do not have your travel documents together for the trip, now is the time to get that passport or a copy of your birth certificate notarized. Look for the information letter with the trip installment schedule, which will be sent home before Thanksgiving break. # Nugget Scrip

We have just received word that Nugget Markets will be changing their Scrip program, which will necessitate everyone currently participating in it to receive a new card. Nugget will be sending out a new card, with a letter explaining how to activate it, to everyone who has used their current Scrip card within the last twelve months. I believe the new system will work exactly like the current Safeway/E-Scrip program, requiring an initial registration on a designated website, with a yearly renewal required. Once this is done, however, the use of the card will be much simpler - just present it to the cashier for a swipe before you scan your credit card or pay your cash, etc., and Band Boosters will automatically benefit. There will be no more pre-loading required at the check stand, which will make the whole process much simpler. The new program is to take effect on December 1, 2010. Evidently, the new cards will be sent out in mid-November. (Note: Nugget asks all current participants to please try their best to use up the funds they have scanned into their current cards by December 1. If, however, you have remaining funds on your card on December 1, Nugget will reimburse you with a check.) I am hoping to have a good supply of the new cards to distribute in time for the upcoming concerts, so be on the lookout for me in the lobby at those times. # Ho, Ho, Holiday Rent-A-Band!

The Rent-A-Band fundraiser has been a fixture of the DHS bands for over 25 years! People and businesses throughout Davis have hired small groups of students to provide holiday entertainment at all sorts of gatherings. These student groups provide the musical "cheer" for events, while reaping financial rewards for their efforts.

All DHS band students who attend at least two rehearsals and return permission slips prior to their first gig are eligible to participate. Student rehearsals are scheduled for one and a half hours immediately after the last school period on November 16<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, and 18<sup>th</sup>.

Only one permission slip is needed to participate in any or all Rent-A-Band performances. As gigs are ordered by the public, Maki Kuper (Rent-A-Band parent coordinator) will post sign-up sheets with the date and time for each gig on the bulletin board in the band room. Students may sign up for as many gigs as they want. Their spot is not guaranteed, however, until they receive a confirmation call from one of the student leaders and a driver has been identified for the gig. This year we will send out groups of twelve to deliver a fuller sound, and to insure that nobody is playing a part alone.

If you are planning a party during the holidays, why not hire a Rent-A-Band group as entertainment? You will be surprised at how much fun it is to delight your guests with live music.

Parents, if your student has signed up and been confirmed, please consider driving the group. It's a great chance to see them perform and really gets you into the holiday spirit! Drivers also need to fill out the appropriate school district driver form showing proper insurance coverage. These need to be on file before you drive any students for Rent-A-Band performances. If you would like to volunteer to drive or would like to order a performance, please email me at maki.kuper@gmail.com with your name, address, home and cell phone numbers, and we will email you the form you need to fill out. The forms for students and drivers will also be available at the rehearsals.

Students will earn funds for their individual accountings. Please note that pianists have to provide their own music, practice independently, and may have to transport their keyboard, if they have one.

#### Band Booster Minutes ~ October 6, 2010 □

The meeting was called to order at 7:35 pm.

<u>Minutes</u> - The minutes from our June, 2010 and September, 2010 meetings as published in the September newsletter were unanimously approved.



<u>Music Director's Report</u> - Mr. Lange says exciting things are happening in all the groups. At the Davis Jazz & Beat Festival on October 9<sup>th</sup>, the Jazz Combo will perform at 1:45pm and the Jazz Band will perform at 4:15pm. "Legends and Scoundrels" is the theme for the Symphonic Band performance in November. The Concert Band is preparing for the December concerts. All are working very hard and are an amazing group of kids. Additionally, coming soon is a wonderful event called the Outreach Concert where the bands play for all the 6<sup>th</sup> graders and then the 6<sup>th</sup> graders join the high school bands. There will be an Ice Cream fundraising opportunity immediately after the concert.

Student's Report - Mr. Lange says the Pep Band performed at the first football game last Friday. The Pep Band was very spirited and took up a huge portion of the stands. On Monday during class there will be a rally and the bands will perform. In the afternoon, the Pep Band will play for a field hockey match and fundraiser for breast cancer research. The students need to be ready at 3:45pm on the 11<sup>th</sup>. Students have a field trip form due to participate in the Pep Band during the Homecoming parade. Friday is Homecoming.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> - There is nothing new to report from last month.

#### Committee reports -

- A. <u>Car Wash</u> (Joyce/Theresa) The first car wash went well. We brought in \$880. The sophomores received a bit of training from the juniors and seniors. Things seemed to flow really well and it was well organized. It looked like students were having fun. 11/6 is next car wash.
- B. <u>Davis (Natsoulas) Jazz Festival</u> (John) The festival is this Saturday. We will hold a raffle at the Davis Commons. A list of prizes was emailed to all families. Posters for the event are being displayed around town. All are encouraged to come listen to some great music. All the sound activities are covered. We may need some help in the raffle tent. John will email families if he needs help with this. The shade structure will be delivered around 9:30am. Joyce recognized Teresa Lucas for her efforts collecting 50 or so prizes from the Davis retailers for our raffle and for Coconut Grove. A table for the sale of raffle tickets will be set up at the Farmer's Market. The drawing will be at 5pm. You do not have to be present to win. Sheila Allen will be the MC for the day.
- C. <u>Pizza and Yogurt</u> (Katie) Thurs 10/21 Following the Outreach Concert, students and their families are encouraged to participate in our fundraiser at Baskin Robbins. Coupons will be available at the concert and at the Band Boosters website.
- D. <u>Direct Donations</u> (Joyce/Kathryn) Julie Hochman has created a rough draft of a letter. The final draft will be done this week. The campaign will kick off soon.
- E. Rent-a-Band (Maki) We will have groups of 12 go out with three leaders. Last year's difficulty in quality control will be addressed in this way. Kids will sign up at rehearsals so they know their groups and will maintain balanced instrumentation. This should allow for bigger and better performance groups.
- F. <u>Playathon</u> (Sandra) They are just starting on the planning. The reservations for the MPR and Room O-01 are already done.
- G. <u>Coconut Grove</u> (John) The MPR and Room O-01 have been reserved for this event. We are looking for a couple people to co-chair this committee. Several people have agreed to coordinate different parts of the event. If anyone is interested in leading the committee please contact John Horn. The committee needs to start planning for this super fun and important event.
- H. <u>Concerts, CD/DVD sales</u> There are a few people who offered to help with concerts and CD/DVD sales. John will get their names to Peggy.
- I. <u>Victoria Spring Trip</u> (Katie) We had our first planning meeting last week. If the trip is approved by the District we will leave on Thursday May 19<sup>th</sup> and will return on Tuesday May 24<sup>th</sup>. Air, bus and hotel reservations are being secured now. Information about the trip will be frequently updated on the Band Boosters website. There are lots of opportunities for fundraising for the trip. Usually the fundraising does not cover the entire cost of the trip so that parents will need to make some contribution. Everyone can go on the trip. One of the purposes of the Band Boosters organization is to ensure that anyone who wants to go on the trip may go and financial assistance is available to anyone who inquires. All inquires are confidential and should be directed to Band Boosters President John Horn. The number of chaperones needed is determined by how many students

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participate in the trip. This year some parents may come as band groupies and attend the trip, but not have official chaperone responsibilities. Details about passports are listed on the website. Please review this information.

- J. <u>Jazz Band Update</u> (David) The Delta Jazz Festival is coming up in December. David Cross and Mr. Lange will need to meet soon to start planning for that event.
- K. <u>Scrip</u> (Lynne) There seems to be a lot of interest in the Scrip program this year. Lynne has cards available for SaveMart, Nugget and Safeway.
- L. <u>Website</u> Wes Young has been doing a terrific job of making our website functional and useful. Mr. Lange has been posting information for students on the website. We will be frequently posting information on the website: http://groups.dcn.org/dhsbandboosters or http://dhsbandboosters.com
- M. Newsletter Joyce Boulanger has done an outstanding job with our newsletter.

- B. Superintendent and Assoc. Superintendent Winfred Roberson and Bruce Colby attended our meeting. They will be visiting several booster programs and came to support our Band Boosters
- C. We have the opportunity to distribute some raffle tickets this evening to anyone interested. They will be available off school grounds following the meeting.
- D. Normally the BB meetings do not conflict with the DHS PTA meetings. This month it was held on the first Wednesday of the month; usually the Band Boosters meetings are held on the second Wednesday of each month.
