Hope to see everyone there!

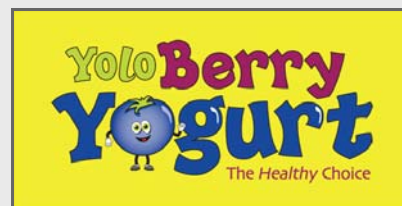

Restaurateur donates \$10,000 to school arts, music



Bobby Coyote, founder and owner of the Dos Coyotes fast-casual restaurant chain, recently donated \$10,000 to the Davis schools to support arts programs. Sue Cockrell/Enterprise photo

Veteran Davis restaurateur Bobby Coyote has donated \$10,000 to the Davis school district as a way of saying “thank you” for the education that two members of his family received in local schools.

“It was one of those things. We had two kids that went through the Davis school system,” Coyote told The Enterprise in an interview at his East Davis office. “My daughter Colby is just graduating this year from UCLA. And my fiancée Margo’s son Kyle attended the schools here as well.

“So I was reflecting on everything, all the great experiences, and the fact that Colby is graduating from college brought it all back to how she started at North Davis Elementary and then attended Emerson Junior High and Davis High School, and all the great teachers she had. Davis is fortunate to have all these great teachers.

“And working with Judy Davis (now retired) when she was the principal at North Davis — she’s the Michael Jordan of elementary school principals.”

Coyote also expressed appreciation for the staff at Emerson.

“When my daughter entered junior high, that was quite the transition — which a lot of kids go through,” he said. “There were teachers who spotted what was going on, and they gave me a call and we were able to get it straightened out real quickly.

“So I was reflecting on it, and I thought, ‘Let’s donate some money to the schools,’” Coyote said. “It’s one of those things we wanted to do. And I’ve always been into the arts and music programs — it seems that in so many districts, those are always the first to get cut.

“So I specified that’s where I wanted the money to go.”

Coyote has two popular Dos Coyotes restaurants in Davis — the original eatery in The Marketplace in North Davis that recently celebrated its 20th anniversary, and another in the Oakshade Town Center in South Davis that has been in business for more than 10 years.

Coyote also has five other restaurants outside of Davis, and another Dos Coyotes will open in October at Sacramento International Airport.

Trustee Gina Daleiden accepted the donation on behalf of the Davis school district, and said the gift is especially appreciated in a year like this one.

“While we’ve struggled with some of the worst cuts in state funding in recent memory, we’ve also seen a ray of hope in the incredible community support for our Davis schools,” she said.

“The larger community stands behind our schools with parcel taxes for instruction, and individual donors and foundations put their time, effort and resources into supporting education.

“Bobby Coyote is a generous and consistent supporter of our schools and our students. As the owner of Dos Coyotes, he is a wonderful example of a local business owner deeply invested in his community,” she continued. “We’re so grateful that he is stepping up again to offer even more to help bring quality art and music instruction to our students.”

This is a pretty simple job, requiring a few hours of coordination before the date of departure, and then helping out the morning of departure as students check-in and drop-off luggage. Also, we are now collecting the **1st installment of \$250**. You may make checks payable to DHS Band Boosters, and mail them to the Band mailbox, (P.O. We appreciate everyone getting this done as soon as possible, as we are now starting to make payments to various places for this trip.

Eric Burger, DHS alumnus and professional trombonist, was a wonderful guest conductor during the "Play-Along" hour, when the band was joined by friends, alumni and 12 to 15 visiting Junior High students. After the visitors left, band students had an energizing hour of pizza, dancing and an amazing "create-a-costume" contest won by the trumpet section. Students did a superb job with the music during a series of "theme hours" conducted by guests Bobby Rogers (Pioneer High Band and Woodland Community Band Director), Tom Slabaugh (Aggie Band Director) and his Assistant Director Olin Hammun (DHS Alumnus 2004), Brian Jones (DHS Alumnus 2010), Soren Christian (Aggie Band Student Conductor, DHS Alumnus 2008), and our own Pep Band Director, Jenny Horn. **Special thanks** go to Eli Smith for his great job coordinating dance music, Lynne Rumery (food/beverage coordinator), Luci Schmidl (check-in coordinator), the many parents that donated time, food, beverages and materials, and an intrepid set of chaperones (John Horn, Lyle Najita, John Weir, Tracy Skinner and Cindy True). Most of the participants didn't realize that the evening would have come to an early close if it had not been for the ingenuity of these chaperones in heading off a major flood of the Emerson Indoor Commons. A plugged roof drain led to rain water pouring into an enclosed atrium that rapidly filled like a giant fishbowl and leaked water into the room faster than it could be mopped up. 🎵 Band Booster Minutes ~ January 4, 2012 🎵



I. The Minutes from our December 2011 meeting, as published in the January newsletter, were unanimously approved.

II. Music Director's Report – The Adjudication Concert is January 22nd (not the 15th). Jazz Band won their division at Delta Jazz Band Festival, with one judge giving them a perfect score. There is a large trophy in the band room. Folsom Jazz Festival is on January 28th. The Winter Concerts went wonderfully. Mr. Quick says the new audition dates are Feb 27th thru March 2nd. These have been changed to allow the school district to prepare a master calendar, and so the students receive schedules sooner in the school year. The online calendar will be adjusted.

III. Student Report – The Pep Band schedule for basketball will be available on the calendar and the website, dhs.bandboosters.com. Pep Band is adding another game this Saturday evening, January 7th, at 7p.m. Mr. Quick will confirm with the Athletic Director. Mr. Dupertuis had surgery over winter break and a journal for students and families to sign is available at this meeting.

IV. Treasurer's Report – Slides were shown, with a comparison from last month and January. Checking account balance has increased with more donations and concert proceeds. \$150 of the money the Jazz Alumni donated from their concert will cover IPAB expenses. Donations comprise the biggest part of our revenues to date at \$19,333. Davis Jazz Festival brought in \$3,014, Scrip \$730, and Car Wash \$930.

V. Committee Reports

- A. Pizza & Yogurt Fundraisers – Mr. Lange will encourage families to go get ice cream after the elementary concerts on 1/31, 2/8 and 2/14. Carrie Juchau has been planning a Round Table Pizza evening and will contact Yoloberry.
- B. Direct Donations – A new \$2,500 donation just came in.
- C. Rent-A-Band – \$925 was collected this year with 19 students in only 8 gigs. Leaders earned \$15/gig and players earned \$10/gig. John Horn requested that Maki write up her tasks to pass along to the next coordinator.
- D. Winter Break Jazz Combo Benefit Concert – A few alumni organized a jazz concert with a cut of the proceeds going towards funding of the New Orleans trip. Thanks to Neil Heaton, Oscar Garibay, Isaac Bunch, Jon Hatamiya, and Colin McDaniel for the \$663.
- E. Play-A-Thon Update – Jeanette Vance is holding a planning meeting immediately after this Band Boosters meeting. This team building event allows students to earn funds towards their band trip accounting. Evening of playing songs followed by short breaks all night long is Fri. Jan. 20th at 7p.m., to 7a.m. on Sat. Jan. 21st. Permission slips will be sent out week of Jan. 9th. The pledge forms were sent out during winter break through the listserv and will be on the website. Family, friends and alumni will have opportunity to play with the group, or conduct the group for \$25. This year there will be no formal concerts before or after. A cake walk is planned to raise additional funds. Other activities include ice breakers, team building, pizza break, cycles of playing & 15 minute breaks. Volunteers can go to signupgenius.com to sign up.
- F. Coconut Grove – Plans are well organized. We can always use help especially from 10th grade parents. More information will be sent out on listserv.
- G. Concerts, CD/DVD Sales – We are not losing money on sales this year. Yet, several IOU's are not being paid. When the product is delivered we need to collect money. John will talk to Mike about collections.
- H. San Diego Spring Trip – Katie says the second installment for trip is due January 20th. A reminder will be sent out. We are still waiting to hear from 30 families whether they will be attending. This year trip will probably cost \$550-575/student. We may be able to go with 2 busses, limiting the number of chaperones needed.
- I. New Orleans Jazz Band Trip – The flights changed and the return flight is now departing at 3p.m., back at 8p.m. (going at 2:30p.m., arrive 11p.m.). John is confirming activities and venues in and around French Quarter. John and Mr. Lange will meet in next two weeks to discuss the trip logistics. John will send out a reminder about trip confirmation and deposit due.
- J. Scrip – no new information.

VI. Other Stuff

- A. Folsom Jazz Festival – Mr. Lange will submit the field trip form this week or next. Lynne Rumery has trip forms organized.
