THE MEETING WAS CALLED to order at 7:30pm.

Minutes – A motion for the approval of the minutes of the February 6 Booster meeting was made and seconded, and it passed by voice vote. The minutes from tonight's meeting will be posted in the upcoming newsletter for consideration on March 28^{th} .

Band Director's Report – Mr. Tom Slabaugh gave the Director's Report.

Treasurer's Report – Deepali Bhargava provided the Treasurer's Report for review at the meeting.

available in the case of emergencies. The checking account starts each school year with a balance of about \$15,000, then increases as we deposit all the funds raised during the year. The checking account balance typically gets quite large just before we start writing checks related to trip expenses, then it drops rapidly. Our goal is to again have a year-end checking account balance of at least \$15,000.

Band Buddy Pilot Program Begins



DHS BAND MEMBERS ARE piloting a Band Buddy Program with young band students from César Chávez Elementary School (CCE). DHS students have been teamed up with a 5th or 6th grader (sometimes more than one!) to tutor them with their instrument and their music. Once a week, DHS students go to CCE and practice scales and current music pieces and mentor them. It is hoped this connection will help







the young students to continue with music, encourage them to play more and inspire them to continue through high school. It is also nice to see so many high school students putting in the time and effort for this mentoring. This is just a pilot program that, with enough interest, could continue in the future. 


