Welcome and Introductions

1. Approve May 2012 Minutes

Trish moved to approve. Pat Poyner seconded it.

2. Principal's Report (Mr. Boonchuoy)

General Announcements. There were many exciting events over the summer. The new common core subject standards for language arts and math focus on deeper learning, critical thinking and problem solving. These emphasize the core goals and strengths of Da Vinci's problem based learning approach and as part of the preparation for implementation of these standards Da Vinci will be administering the College and Work Readiness Assessment to seniors and 9<sup>th</sup> grade students this year. Also, in light of these changes DJUSD supported DaVinci faculty in providing a two day professional development seminar for teachers in the district. Great things also happened for the school staff this summer. They held a retreat for DV staff focusing on the future changes for the school. The Buck institute sent a film crew to record the retreat as an exemplary model of staff development. Also Mr. Milsap, Ms. Munoz, and Ms. Fowler received the Best in the Network Award from the New Tech Network for their junior year project in which students interview veterans- "America at War." Da Vinci continues to be a model New Tech school and is expecting many important visitors this year to see the program. The visits are energizing and help make the program stronger by forcing us to live up to our bragging rights.

## a. DV Jr. High Announcements and Q&A

Junior High Announcements: DaVinci Junior High has moved to the B pod of the Emerson/DaVinci Campus. Classes are full with an average of 33 students. The only DaVinci class with a waiting list is 8<sup>th</sup> grade; all others desiring a place were accepted. The tech upgrade for the junior high cost \$16,000, which was largely financed by the district with funds, they received from us as rent because of our charter school

b. High School Announcements: Class at DaVinci high school average 32 students compared to an average of 37 at Davis High School. The tech upgrade at the high school included a new server, firewall and access points as well as 70 new computers. Cost of \$24,000 financed largely by the district in same manner as junior high and partially by Boosters. The technology at DaVinci needs significant further upgrading. Many computers will go off warrantee this year and the school will not be able to keep many of them functioning. At this point about 30% of students at the high school are bringing home computers to school which helps. We need to encourage this.

## If budgets do not pass in November, tech needs will be a challenge.

- c. Budget: District wide and statewide school finances are in serious jeopardy. If the Statewide Proposition 30 fails to pass DaVinci will loose \$440 per student or more than \$250,000 for this school year. There will also be significant impact Measure E fails. Plans are being made for this contingency which include possible 5.5% pay cuts district wide or furlough days. This will be determined after the election. Currently there is a freeze on all nonessential spending.
- d. Dress code was discussed.
- e. Professional Development for staff will be around critical thinking.
- f. Tomorrow is first late start day (Sept. 5).
