Eye Spy!



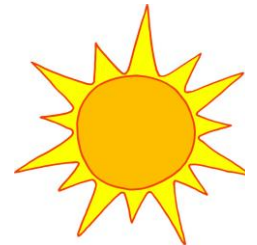
