Harper Band Booster's – October 15th, 2009 minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7:07 pm.

1. It was motioned, seconded and voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the previous meeting, Tuesday, September 22nd.
2. Band Director's, Ken Bower and Adriana Sandoval, mentioned:
 - a. Ken Bower plans to take the 9th graders to see the DHS Symphonic Band on Monday, November 16th.
 - b. Winter Concerts: Concert Bands on Tuesday, December 8th AND Jazz Band and Choir on Friday, December 11
 - c. Adriana mentioned the possibility of two festivals that would be beneficial for the Jazz Band to attend.
 - i. It was motioned, seconded and voted unanimously to allow Adriana to take the Jazz Band to both festivals – the Band Boosters would pay the entrance fees.
 1. The Delta Jazz Festival on Saturday, December 5th
 2. The Folsom Jazz Festival on Saturday, January 30th
 - d. Ken and Adriana would like to have the bands play at an Elementary Outreach Program in the Spring.
 - i. It was also suggested that a flyer goes home, specifically with 6th grade band students at the three "feeder" elementary schools (Montgomery, Pioneer and Korematsu) to advertise the two December concerts.
 - e. After much discussion, it was motioned, seconded and voted unanimously to have the 9th graders attend the "Music in the Park" field trip in the spring. The Band Boosters will pay the entrance fees.
3. Treasurer's Report – Laure Lee
 - a. There was very little activity the previous month (September 23rd to October 12th)
 - b. Current balance was \$3519.78
 - c. As a group we looked over the proposed budget and made a few changes (see attachment)
 - i. It was motioned, seconded and voted unanimously to adopt The Proposed Budget.

5. Fundraising Report
