

## **Board Meeting Minutes for March 11, 2021 Old North Davis Neighborhood Association (ONDNA)**

Our meeting convened at 6:00 pm via Zoom, due to social distancing.

**Attendees:** ONDNA Board members present were: John Meyer, Angela Willson, Gerrit Mulholland, Steve Tracy, Greg Frantz, and Lucas Welch, Other attendees were Marian Stephenson, John Lofland, and Cyndi Marshall.

**Start Meeting.** The minutes for our February 11 meeting were approved with minor editorial changes. The agenda for the current meeting was approved with an addition to discuss the City of Davis Planning Commission's recent change in its housing strategy. This action was apparently done without adequate public notice, and John Meyer will discuss this with our local Councilman Lucas Frerich. No change to our bank account.

**Neighborhood Projects.** The property at 626 B Street is currently on the market. There is little more that the Board needs to be involved with regarding this property. The noise nuisance at 513 E Street has been pursued via contacting the property owner. The outcome of this contact is currently unknown.

**Police Advisory Board.** Board member Angela Willson reported that the Police Board this month has reported that the usual enforcement of street parking, previously temporarily suspended, will again soon go into effect. The Police Human Relations Committee also continues to track complaints and other issues regarding public interaction with the Davis police department.

**Tree Planting.** Almost all new trees have now been planted, and there now needs to be continued follow-up to ensure that new trees are properly cared for (watered).

**Alleys.** Our alleys continue to need improvements to alleviate flooding of neighborhood structures that abut them. The City of Davis owns our alleys, and is therefore responsible for their care and maintenance. John Meyer has spoken to our local Councilman Lucas Frerich about our issues, but we still have not heard anything from the City.

**Road Resurfacing.** This is scheduled for April, and some work has already been done near 6th and D Streets.

**Other Non-Agenda Items.** Marian Stephenson has volunteered to help in maintaining the Lyda Willams memorial garden at mid-block E Street, and has already done some weed clearing. We thank Marian for her ministrations. Lastly, there were some complaints regarding inadequate street sweeping that should be addressed to Recology.

**Our meeting was adjourned at about 6:50 pm.** Our next meeting is scheduled for Thursday April 8, 2021 from 6-7pm via Zoom.
