




Results Matter: What are consequences when... two in three felons end up back in prison within three years.

Recidivism Rates: All Paroled Felons Released from Prison for First Time in 2005




And when our per inmate costs are going up faster than... well, faster than anywhere else

Change in Per Inmate Prison Costs (Inflation Adjusted), 2001-2005







CA Lawmakers: Twice as Many Constituents


Residents per Lawmaker: Most Populous States





California Historical Voter Registration 1922-2008




Partisan Gridlock



Regional Economies Define CA's Nation-State Landscape




Milken: Steady Decline in the Economic Performance of California Cities






Do people in state government waste a lot of the money we pay in taxes, some, or not very much?






Is state government run by a few big interests looking out for themselves or for the benefit of all of the people?






Public Approval of the Legislature is at Record Lows


